## Transportation services available from the Rio...

The Rio has provided excellent transportation options at no cost to their guests. You can't beat that!

Rio is a part of Caesars Entertainment which owns 8 major Las Vegas properties and provides shuttle service between the Rio, Bally's and Harrah's every 15 to 30 minutes. This shuttle operates between 10am and 1am daily. It is a very short ride just over the freeway to their sister properties in the heart of the strip.

In addition, just a short walk to the Palms will also get you a shuttle to some of the other strip destinations; Fashion Show Mall just across from the Wynn and Encore and the Forum Shops connected to Caesars. This is also a free service so please check their site for departure times.

The cab and limo situation is plentiful at the Rio and really is almost a "no wait" situation, not like what you experience dealing with the strip casinos.

Being off the strip means shorter cab rides resulting is lower fares making the downtown Fremont Street Experience more affordable to visit. If you have not experienced Fremont Street, go there and try the new Zip Line. It will take you about a half a block right under the canopy and over Fremont Street as hundreds of people watch from below.

Rental cars become a better option now that the congestion of the strip is not that big of a concern. Just make plans, Google map your location and find out what the locals know about getting around Vegas the easy way. If you are in a hurry just try to avoid the strip at all cost.
